Recipient Criteria

Major: History

Schools: All universities and colleges located in East Texas, defined as those schools east of IH 35 and extending southeasterly from Dallas to Houston.

GPA: 3.0 overall and 3.2 in History

Other: Preference may be given to students in Texas history, especially East Texas history. Need may be considered, if all things are equal between candidates.
